Kathryn Rose “Katie” Proctor-Schiff, 35, of Evansville, passed away on Tuesday, October 12, 2021 at Deaconess Hospital Gateway Campus.

Katie was the ultimate boy mom; her three sons meant the world to her. She was passionate about St. Joseph Catholic School where they attended. She served on the St. Joseph Catholic School Board and volunteered her time there. Katie had also owned and operated PenPals and KnitWitts for over 15 years before making the decision to devote her life to her boys.

Surviving Katie are her husband of 10 years, Jake Schiff; three sons, Webber, Morris and Payne Schiff; her mother, Kris Proctor; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Mark and Judy Schiff; brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Adam and Jamie Schiff and nephews, Palmer and Spencer Schiff and niece, Berkley Schiff.
