Katherine "Katie" Kanowsky, 26, of Knoxville, TN, passed away Friday, May 1, 2009 in Evansville, IN. Katie was born on July 17, 1982 in Evansville.

Katie was a 2001 graduate of North Posey High School and a 2007 graduate of Murray State University. At Murray State she was an active member of Alpha Omicron Pi sorority and Murray State Student Government. After graduation from Murray State University, she was employed at the Y-12 National Security Complex, in Oak Ridge, TN, in the business development group.

Katie has a zest for life that few could match. Katie has always enjoyed being very active, as highlighted by the many years she spent playing sports, traveling and shopping. However, her favorite activity was spending time with her family, friends, and co-workers.
