Kenneth Bert Settle, age 86, of Evansville, passed away Monday, January 07, 2013, at the Evansville Protestant Home. He was born September 30, 1926, in Hamilton, Ohio.

After serving in the U.S. Army during W.W. II, Ken received his bachelor of science in education degree at the University of Cincinnati, master of business administration degree at Indiana University, and doctorate degree at the University of Cincinnati. He held memberships in Phi Delta Kappa and Delta Pi Epsilon, professional honor societies, and a 3-year term on the Committee of Management at the University of Cincinnati YMCA.

Ken had worked at the University of Cincinnati, where he served as Vice President of Planning, Assistant Dean of Summer School and instructor in business education; served as President of the Penn Valley Community College, Kansas City, Missouri, and taught at Ball State University before retiring from the University of Southern Indiana as the Dean of the School of Business.

Ken's lifelong love for golf began as a caddy. He was an avid sports fan. Ken was a loyal supporter of USI and F.J. Reitz High School academics and athletics. He enjoyed jazz and all things Cincinnati: college and professional sports, Skyline chili, and Graeter's ice cream. After retirement, Ken traveled

abroad extensively.
