Kevin R. Milton, age 58, of Newburgh, passed away Monday, August 13, 2012 at his home.

Kevin had worked as a Tool Maker for 39 years throughout the Evansville area and most recently at Huff Technologies in Morganfield, KY. He was an avid St. Louis Cardinals and Indiana University Basketball Fan.
