Kim Allison (Knapp) Weyer passed away on November 8, 2019 from Amyotrophic Lateral Sclerosis (ALS).

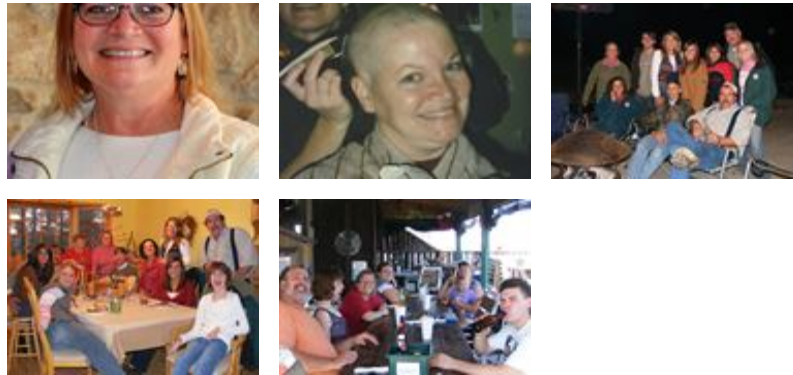
