Larry L. Alsop, 79, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, January 5, 2020.

Larry was born August 5, 1940 in Evansville to the late Charles and Mary (Sprinkle) Alsop. He was a veteran of the United States Army; retired from the Evansville Police Department after 20 years of service and also retired from 911 Special Investigations in Indianapolis where he was a fraud investigator. Larry also worked as a corporate security officer for the American International Group in Lake Mary, NY.

Surviving Larry are three daughters, Laura (Tony) Douglas of Corona, CA, Patty (Rob) Montgomery of Evansville and Ellen (David) Fleig of Carmel, IN; one brother, Lewis Eugene "Gene" Alsop of Elk Grove, CA; four grandchildren, Samantha and Cameron Montgomery and Katie and Jackson Fleig; nephew, Major Steven Alsop of the United States Marine Corps as well as several other nieces and nephews.

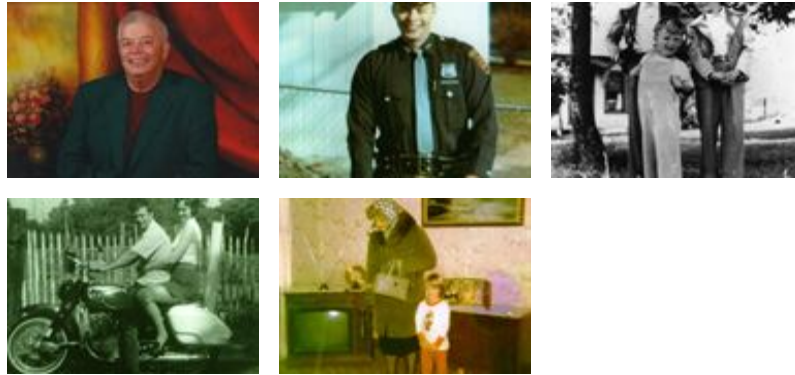
