Larry O. Lewis, 79, of rural Evansville, passed away at his home on Thursday, June 12, 2025. Larry was a devoted family man and beloved community member. He will be deeply missed by all who had the pleasure of knowing him.

Larry was born on April 16, 1946. He was a 1964 graduate of FJ Reitz High School. He went on to live a life defined by service, leadership, and love for his family and community.

Larry proudly served in the United States Army and was stationed in Munich, Germany. Following his military service, he became a leader in his profession, serving as co-owner of Midwest Roofing and Sheet Metal and the President of the Sheet Metal and Air Conditioning Contractor's Association (SMACNA). 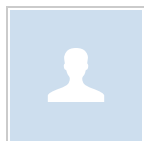
