Lawrence L. Logel, age 97, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, June 11, 2014 at his home.

Mr. Logel had worked as a tool and die maker for Whirlpool Corporation for 46 years before retiring in 1982 and was a member of the Whirlpool Retirees Club. Lawrence was a veteran of the United States Navy serving in the South Pacific during World War II. He was also a member of VFW Post #1114.
