Lawrence A. Ubelhor, 83, of Evansville, passed away Monday, July 02, 2012 at Deaconess Hospital.

He was born, March 30, 1929 in Evansville and attended Memorial High School, graduating in 1947.

He was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in Vanderburgh County, where he was the choir director and co-chair of the annual church picnic for many years and a member of the Men's Club. He received the Brute Award from the Diocese of Evansville for his service to the church. Larry was a masonry contractor, served in the United States Army National Guard for 25 years and operated Ubelhor's Christmas Tree Farm on #6 School Road from 1957 to 2011. He was a member of the Indiana Christmas Tree Growers Association and volunteered at St. Vincent de Paul Food Pantry.
