Lawrence G. Weber, age 96, of Evansville, passed away Monday, January 2, 2017 at the West River Health Campus.

Larry was born November 2, 1920 in Evansville to the late Frank and Bernadine (Brandsasse) Weber. Larry worked at many jobs throughout the years, including Bucyrus Erie for seven years, as a salesman for Western & Southern Life Insurance for twenty five years and as a school bus driver for seventeen years.
