Leo G. Weinzapfel, age 89, of Mt. Vernon, IN passed away on Tuesday, May 2, 2023 at the West River Health Campus.

Leo was born November 28, 1933 in Evansville to the late Florian and Mary (Holzgrebe) Weinzapfel. He was a graduate of Mater Dei High School and the founder and operator of Weinzapfel Mill and Building. He later retired from Weinzapfel Custom Homes, Inc. Leo was a long-time member of St. Philip Catholic Church. He enjoyed woodworking, gardening and making toys for children.
