Leon C. Rexing, age 79, of Evansville, died Sunday, February 20, 2011 at his home.

Leon was born May 11, 1931. He was a 1950 graduate of Reitz High School and an avid Green Bay Packers and Brett Farve fan. He was also an avid fan of Roy Rogers and owned everything he ever made.
