



## Linda Louise Marshall

September 28, 1940 - June 11, 2025

Linda Louise Bullock Marshall passed away peacefully on June 11, 2025, at the age of 84.

A loving mother, sister, daughter, and a friend to many, she was known for her work ethic, for being opinionated and for her love of all things social. Linda was beloved for her warmth and her ability to talk to anyone, including during her final years at Park Terrace Village. She never knew a stranger.

Born September 28, 1940, in Waverly, Kentucky, Linda grew up on the family farm in Union County. She graduated from St Vincent Academy in 1958. She moved to Evansville after high school and graduated from Lockyear's Business College in 1960. She immediately secured a secretarial position at Mead Johnson in the lab. She retired from Mead Johnson (acquired by Bristol Myers Squibb during her tenure) after 32 years of service and many administrative roles in several different divisions of the company. She loved her work and was always eager to learn a new skill.

Linda enjoyed many leisure pursuits including dancing, attending music events, cooking, and in her later years, playing mah jong with a passion. She was a member of the Mead Johnson retiree group and the River Bend Auxiliary. She loved traveling and took many trips across the US and to Rome and Ireland. She enjoyed family events most of all from reunions to holiday

celebrations to small gatherings.

She was a member of St. Paul's United Church of Christ and gained strength from her faith and joy from her church community.

Linda is survived by her children, John Marshall and Julie Marshall (Bob Reibach) and grandchildren Emily, Sam and Jillian Marshall, her siblings, Clara Wilson (Emery), Marie Hall (Greg), Paul Bullock (Denise). Also, step-granddaughters Lori Reibach (Fletcher Grow), Ashleigh Reibach Huggett (Rich) and great grandsons Afton, Ezra and George.

She was preceded in death by her parents, Frank Merle Bullock and Henrietta Thomas Bullock and sister Patricia Crowdus, brother-in-law Benny Crowdus, and niece Christy Crowdus Goff.

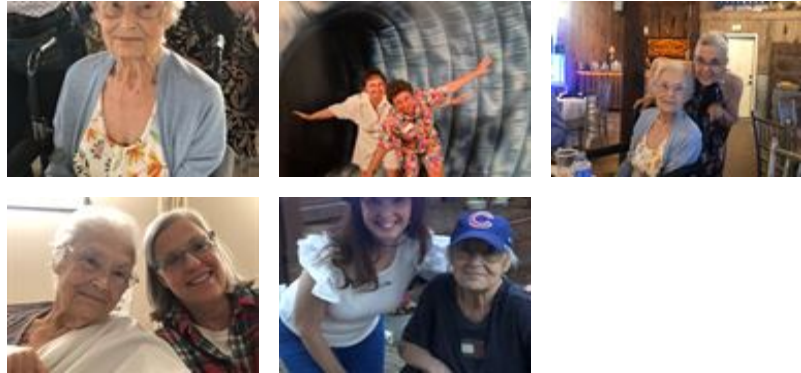
