From the time she was a little girl Lisa always had a busy, happy life with her family because her parents took her everywhere they went. Lisa was friendly and fun loving. She liked music and dancing and had a special gift for remembering the names of every singer and musical group popular during the 60s and 70s. She could identify any famous person of that time by their music or their TV shows. She retained that talent well into her fifties. When someone complimented Lisa for being smart because she could do that, she always replied that she “was born that way”. She especially loved Elvis and called him her boyfriend even after she knew he died.

Lisa attended Marian Day School and Howard Roosa School. Lisa retired from EARC Industries the same year her dad retired from his craft. Recently she took advantage of programs at EARC again and enjoyed the arts and crafts classes there.

After Lisa lost her parents, she lived with her sister Donna Cassin, who became Lisa’s adored “mom” for the next 13 years. In her last few years her

brother Ron and wife Margaret helped with Lisa's care as much as she would allow. She was always very reluctant to be separated from Donna. Ron worked hard at keeping Lisa busy with planned activities to improve her physical and mental well-being. He took her to the Y and she amazed everyone by sometimes making 50 free throws in an hour. She lived over 62 years with the continuous love and care of her family members.

Besides her sister and brother, Lisa is survived by nephews Brian Cassin, Brad Angermeier (Meagan) and Luke Angermeier; nieces Shannon Goebel (Matt), Christen Angermeier, April Angermeier, Cheyenne Angermeier and many great-nieces and nephews.
