



## Lloyd Hupfer

June 29, 1926 - November 19, 2006

Lloyd G. Hupfer, 80, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, November 19, 2006 at Deaconess Hospital.

Mr. Hupfer was a member of St. Boniface Catholic Church, a past member of the Parish Council, where he was head of the Finance Committee, Chairman of the Bingo for 17 years, a founding member of the St. Boniface Booster Club and Twin Towers. He received the Brute Society Award from the Diocese of Evansville in 2000. He was employed at Whirlpool Corporation for 28 years. Before retiring in 1984, he was manager of the Air Conditioning Lab. He was also a member of the Whirlpool Management Club and the American Society for Heating, Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Engineers, a veteran of the U. S. Navy and a member of American Legion Funkhouser Post #8.

He was a graduate of Central High School and Evansville College.

He is survived by his wife of 56 years, Dolores (Mayer) Hupfer, one daughter, Mary Hupfer of Evansville and four sons and three daughters-in-law, Michael Hupfer and his wife, Seiko of Ashland, OH, Darrell Hupfer, and his wife, Jeneil, of Westmont, IL, Richard Hupfer of Bartow, FL and Randall Hupfer, and his wife, Cindy, of Evansville. Two brothers, Harold Hupfer and Ronald Hupfer, both of Evansville and seven grandchildren, Derek and his wife, Jennifer Hupfer, Jeff and his wife, Aimee Hupfer, Leeann Hupfer, Andy Hupfer,

Raymond Hupfer, Christy Hupfer and Noah Hupfer also survive him.

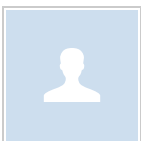
