They also had a passion for their church, Mater Dei High School and the University of Southern Indiana, where he served as President of the Varsity Club, traveling with friends to basketball games, served as Chairman of the annual Fall Festival booth and was honored as the 1st Volunteer of the Year in 1997. 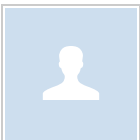

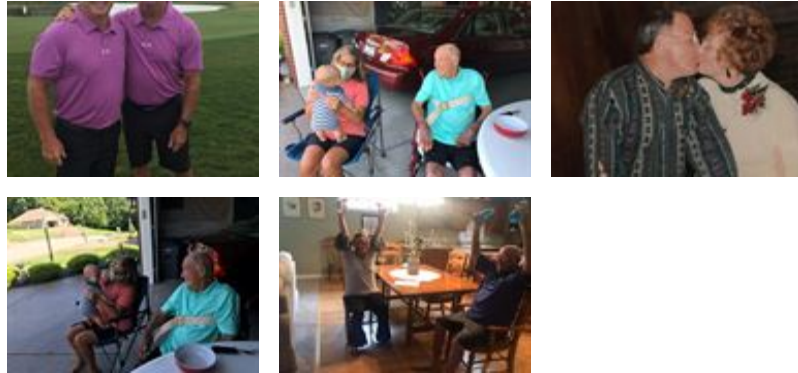

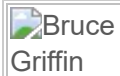
