Lois (Willey) Hardin, 84, formerly of Evansville, passed away Monday, January 20, 2020 in Indianapolis with her family. A graduate of Reitz High School, Lois grew up and lived on the west side of Evansville before relocating to Carmel, Indiana to be near family.

Lois was born August 14, 1935 in Evansville to the late Harold and Mary (Savage) Willey. She was a loving wife, mother, grandmother and great grandmother. Lois will always be remembered for her quick smile, sense of humor, friendly manner, and her love for family, friends, and everyone around her. 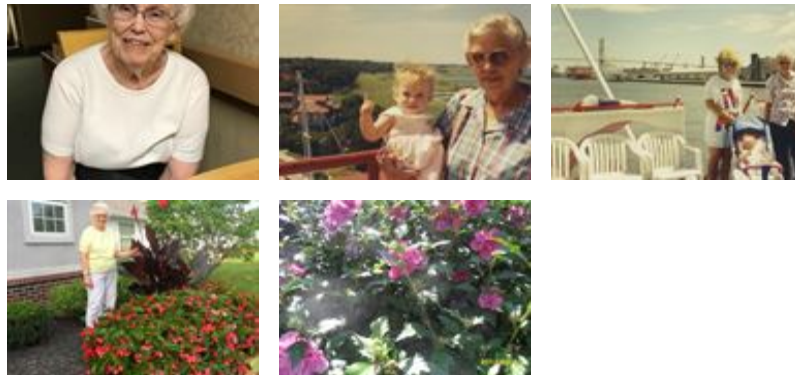
