May 1, 1918 - April 21, 2020

Malinda M. Anslinger, 101, of St. Wendel, passed away Tuesday, April 21, 2020 at her home surrounded by family.

Malinda was born May 1, 1918 in St. Wendel, IN to the late Henry and Rosina (Fals) Goedde.
