Margaret Anne Nicholson, 94, of Mt. Vernon, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 29, 2023 at the Bethel Manor Rehabilitation Cottage.

Anne was born May 7, 1929 in Evansville to the late Bennett Walker and Elizabeth Key (Blackman) Whitehead.
