Margaret Anne Remke, 91, of Evansville, passed away on Friday, September 13, 2024 at Solarbron.

Margaret was born in Dubois County, Indiana on August 27, 1933 to the late Fred J. and Lillian (Taylor) Huber. She worked as an elementary school teacher at Daniel Wertz School for 37 years and later volunteered as the librarian at St. Agnes School for 11 years. Margaret had been nominated as the EVSC Teacher of the Year, she had a lifetime membership in the PTA; enjoyed traveling in her motorhome, participating in family activities and playing UNO. Margaret was also a member of St. Agnes Catholic Church and sang in the St. Agnes Church Choir.

Surviving Margaret are many nieces, nephews, great nieces, great nephews and other extended family.

In addition to her parents, Margaret was preceded in death by her husband of 54 years, Robert J. Remke in 2013; by an infant sister, Mary Lou Huber and by brothers, James, Jack and Norman Huber.
