Marilee (Nance) Jarvis, age 85 of Evansville, passed away Friday, September 04, 2015 at the Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mrs. Jarvis was born January 9, 1930, the third child of the late Clarence and Maude (Joyner) Nance. Her father, Clarence was killed in an accident at Bucyrus Erie, where he was employed in 1942 and her mother died in 1956. Marilee married Andrew Elwood Jarvis on June 28, 1944 and they were married for 47 years. Together, they spent many summer vacations camping and later many summers at their river camp on Old Henderson Road. She was a member of New Bethel Southern Baptist Church.

Surviving to cherish her memory are Vernon Kiesel, her longtime loving companion; her daughter and son-in-law, Jeanette and Bob Hartig of Evansville; granddaughters, Lisa (Jon) Fares of Owensboro, KY, Kimberly (Chris) Austin of Davenport, FL, Amy (Will) Lewis, Lynette (Scott) Reed and Cynthia (David) Brugger, all of Evansville; fourteen great grandchildren and four great great grandchildren. Also surviving are three nieces and a nephew from Elwood's family in Kentucky.

In addition to her parents, Marilee was preceded in death by her husband A. Elwood Jarvis in 1991; by a daughter Paula Williams in 2000; by two older brothers, Harold Nance, who died as a toddler in 1925 and Clyde Ray Nance

who died in 1931 at age 12.
