



## Mark A. Lutterbach

July 26, 1955 - May 6, 2024

Mark A. Lutterbach, 68, of Menomonee Falls, Wisconsin, formerly of Evansville, passed away at Grace Commons in Menomonee Falls.

Mark was a faith-filled husband, father and grandfather who was devoted to loving God and his family and serving others. His upstanding character and trustworthiness made him loved by many and approachable. 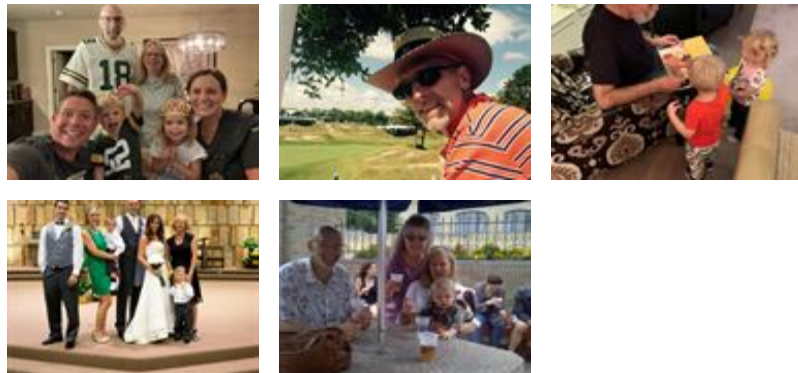
