Martha Jo (Lintzenich) Lamkin, 73, of Evansville, passed away Monday, June 19, 2017 at the Good Samaritan Home.

Martha was born February 27, 1944 in Evansville to the late Henry and Dorothy Mae (Tepool) Lintzenich.
