Mary Jane Bradley, 84, of Evansville, passed away at her home on Friday, January 3, 2025.

Mary Jane was born on February 9, 1940, in Evansville to the late Joseph B. and Cecelia (Scheller) Gries. She was a 1958 graduate of Mater Dei High School, a homemaker, and longtime member of Resurrection Catholic Church. Mary Jane, along with her husband Ernie, was inducted into the Brutè Society of the Diocese of Evansville for their service to the church. She had volunteered for over twenty-two years at the Ozanam Family Shelter; she was also a member of the home economics club, Menage Lore, and the Quilter's Club at Resurrection Church. 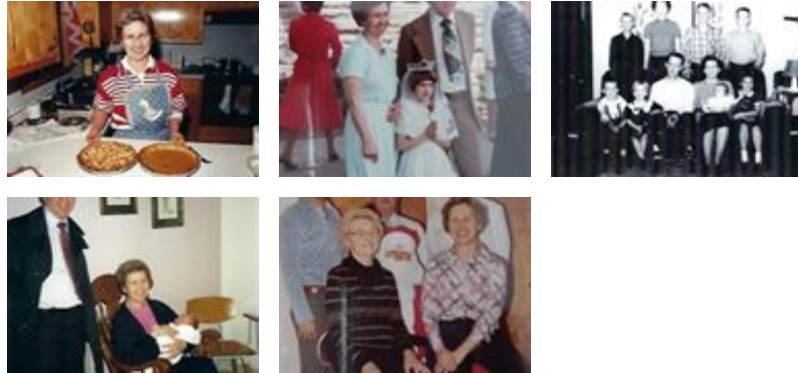
