Mary Lou (Hayes) Huff, 87, of Evansville, passed away Friday, February 10, 2017. She was born on December 7, 1929 in Evansville to the late Robert and Celia (Erbacher) Hayes.

On April 1, 1952 in Newport, Rhode Island, Mary Lou married the love of her life, Ralph Huff, who was in the United States Navy at the time.

Mary Lou graduated from Central High School in 1946. She then moved to Atlanta to attend airline school. Upon completion, she returned to Evansville to work for Eastern Airlines. There she became the first female ticket agent to work for Eastern in Evansville. She then went to work for Mead Johnson and, at the time of her retirement, held the position of Senior Transportation Reservationist. It was her responsibility to arrange travel via the company plane, commercial airline, train, car rental, as well as hotel reservations. She retired in 1985 after 25 years of service.

After retiring, Mary Lou pursued many hobbies. She enjoyed crossword puzzles, sewing, playing bridge, line dancing, ceramics and was an avid reader. She particularly took pride in the over 60 handmade quilts she was able to make. She also traveled extensively, visiting countries all over the world.

She lived in St. Philip for 40 years and attended St. Philip Catholic Church. Recently, she moved to the Rathbone Home where she died peacefully surrounded by the love of her family.

In addition to her parents, Mary Lou was preceded in death by her husband

Ralph Huff in 1999; by a daughter, Debbie in 1995; by a brother, Robert and grandson, Brandt.

Surviving are her triplet sons, Don (Patricia) Huff, Dan Huff and Doug Huff, as well as her daughter, Dian (David) Chatmon. Also surviving are her grandchildren, Loren, Leah, Jake, Philip and Katie.

Mary Lou really enjoyed life and made friends with all she met. Her children will miss their weekly phone calls and frequent visits with her.

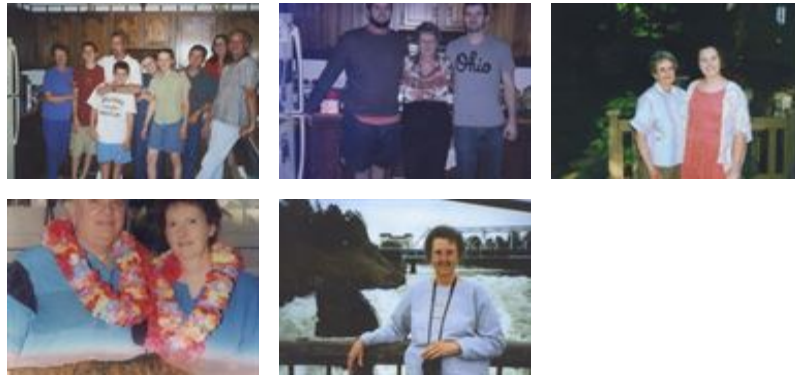
