Mary Ann Schapker, 89, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, March 26, 2024 at the Linda E. White Hospice House.

Mary Ann was born on March 16, 1935 in Evansville to the late Victor and Olivia (Spahn) Kuhn. She was the Director of Operations for the Schapker family household for almost 70 years. Mary Ann was a 1953 graduate of Memorial High School and in recent years enjoyed attending a monthly lunch with a group of her classmates.
