Sue attended Sacred Heart School and later graduated from Mater Dei High School in the class of 1950, where she served as Senior Class Vice President and was chosen as the school's first May Queen.

Sue married Raymond Vescovi in December, 1953 and traveled the southeast with her husband who was a professional baseball player. She worked at Hoosier Cardinal in the early years and Internal Medicine once her children were on their own. Sue dedicated a large portion of her life raising her five children. She was a member of Resurrection Catholic Church, the Red Hatters, and the Italian American Social Club. She enjoyed exercise classes, painting, volunteering at church and community events, and catching Spring Training each year. She loved playing cards, golfing, and spending time with

her family and large circle of friends. Spending winters in her Bonita Springs, Florida home was her most favorite time of year and the community there will sorely miss her vivaciousness and community involvement.
