Mary Doris (Boultinghouse) Wolf, age 90, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, December 25, 2014 at the West River Health Campus. She was born December 13, 1924 in Crossville, IL to the late Loren and Cicely Anne "Annie" (Davenport) Boultinghouse.

Doris was a graduate of Crossville High School and Lockyear Business College. She was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church and VFW Post #1114 Ladies Auxiliary. She had worked as an executive secretary for the Vanderburgh County Commissioners Office from 1976 to 1981, for the Vanderburgh County School Corporation and prior to marriage had worked at Serval. 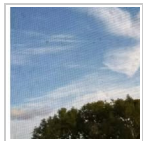
