Matthew T. Rexing, age 41, of Evansville, passed away Wednesday, June 16, 2010 as the result of a fall while working in Tulsa, OK.

Matt, an electrician with the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers Local 16, worked for Industrial Contractors where he was a dedicated worker of fifteen years. Having learned his work ethic from his father, his coworkers knew that if Matt worked on the job, it was done right.

His most treasured joy was his family. Married for eleven years, he and his wife, Lori, joined together to raise a loving family. They spent time together, cooking, reading stories, and enjoying their home which they built. His home was the setting for many Sunday dinners and family gatherings.

Matt and his family attended Salem United Methodist Church where the community embraced them with devoted love and respect. He was a 1986 graduate of Mater Dei High School, where he retained close ties with his friends.
