Melvin R. Niemeier, 67, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, May 21, 2017 at the Linda White Hospice Home.

Mel was born July 11, 1949 in Evansville to Raymond Niemeier and the late Jean (Burch) Niemeier. Mel was a 1967 graduate of Mater Dei High School. He received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Management from the University of Southern Indiana and an MPA from Indiana State University.
