Michael A. Head, 74, of Evansville, passed away peacefully on Friday, September 25, 2015 at Deaconess Hospice. He was the son of the late William F. and Lorena (Hartz) Head.

Mike was a 1954 graduate of Sacred Heart Grade School and a 1958 graduate of Mater Dei High School. He completed his journeyman training with Plumbers and Pipefitters Local 136, eventually achieving Master Plumber certification. Mike served in the Marine Corps Reserves from 1961-1967.

Mike spent his professional career at Industrial Contractor's (SKANSKA) retiring in 2000. When not working, Mike enjoyed several hobbies including gardening and traveling. He took great pleasure in being outdoors and could usually be found working meticulously on the landscaping in his yard. Mike was an active father who enjoyed fishing and camping with his children. A proud and doting Grandfather, Mike reveled in making his grandchildren laugh and attending their sporting events and other activities.

His spirit and sharp wit will be missed by all who knew him.

Mike is survived by Jennie (Buckman), his wife of 50 years, and by his children Lorrie Weiss (Greg), Marcey Vanpell (James), both of Evansville, and Tracey Gannon (Robert) of Orlando, FL. Mike's son, Trevor Head (Debbie) preceded his father's ascension into Heaven in October 2007.
