MICHAEL LAWRENCE

Michael R. Lawrence, age 41, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, November 10, 2013 as the result of a traffic accident.

Mike had been employed at Berry Plastics for 18 years, where he held numerous leadership capacities in the areas of engineering, marketing, quality control and most recently as the Product Manager for healthcare bottles. He was a loving and dedicated family man; heavily involved in his children's activities. He loved spending time with his family and friends, horse racing and the Duke Blue Devils. Mike was a 1990 graduate of FJ Reitz and earned a Bachelor's Degree in Chemical Engineering from Rose Hulman and his Masters of Business Administration from the University of Southern Indiana. Mike was a lifetime member of Trinity Lutheran Church and more recently had attended Christian Fellowship Church with his family. He was also a lifetime member of the Riverbend Association. He was very active in many area organizations, including the United Way of Southwestern Indiana and the Boys and Girls Club of Evansville. He had started his own charity outing, Man Day in 2003. The event began as 14 men taking the afternoon off to play golf and go to the horse track and has grown to an event drawing over 140 men raising money for local charities.

Surviving Mike are his wife of 16 years, Mindy (Sturgeon) Lawrence; three daughters, Caplin Lawrence of O'Fallon, IL and Riley and Maysa Lawrence, both at home; a son, Luke Lawrence at home; his parents, Kelley and Donna (Whittington) Lawrence of Evansville; his sister, Angie Tucker of Evansville; grandmothers, Ruth Lawrence of Evansville and Betty Whittington of Conroe, TX his father-in-law and mother-in-law, Mike and Debbie Sturgeon of Evansville; and sisters-in-law, Andrea Sturgeon and Amy (Tim) Seib. Also surviving are two aunts, Cheryl (Max) Carlisle and Nancy (Mike) Ruttle; nieces and nephews, Izabella and Vivienne Seib and Storm and Talon Tucker and a great nephew, Keagan Tucker.

Mike was preceded in death by his two grandfathers, Clifford R. Lawrence and Floyd M. Whittington.

Funeral services for Mike will be held at 10:00 A.M. on Thursday, November 14, 2013 at Pierre Funeral Home, Rev. Martin Nolan officiating. Burial will follow in Lutheran Cemetery.

In 2006 Mike and I traveled from Evansville to Southern California to see a customer. The trip was a quick 24 hour turnaround. He and I talked throughout the flight. I explained we had lived in southern California for a few years. One thing lead to another and we got on the subject of children. I can close my eyes to this day and remember when we arrived at the cemetery. Mike reached into his overnight bag and pulled out a bright clean white T-shirt. He got the shirt wet and kneeled next to Matthews headstone and began to clean. I stood there my eyes overflowed with tears. After they were finished Mike told me to take my time he and John were going to take a walk, but they would be close by if I needed them. I prayed thanking God for Mike. I felt so blessed. I will never forget Mikes kindness. Mike holds a special place in my heart. He is truly a blessing. I told my husband seven years ago. Mike is definitely heaven bound. Mikes act of kindness his heart of gold touched my whole family. I now pray for comfort and peace for you and your family.
