



## Michael Lowell McKim

August 3, 1982 - May 16, 2026

Michael Lowell McKim passed away on May 16th from injuries sustained in an accident in Bloomington, Indiana.

Mikey was born on August 3rd, 1982, to Juliana Topper McKim and Michael (Mitzi) McKim, and immediately began making friends, a lifelong hobby at which he excelled. First, with his doting older sister Andrea (Greg) Veilleux, then with a close-knit pack of Topper cousins, and finally, across the west side of Evansville, at IU, and in his beloved Haynie's Corner neighborhood. It was not so much that Mikey never met a stranger, but rather that his exuberance, humor and wit were such clear promises of good times ahead that it was impossible not to be drawn in to his orbit.

Mikey graduated from Reitz High School and Indiana University and was employed by Anchor Industries for 18 years. He played disc golf with enthusiasm, was never reading fewer than 3 books at a time, captained neighborhood wiffleball and dart teams, gritted his teeth through the New York Times crossword puzzle daily, and held court as bartender at Spankey's Una Cafe on Sunday and Monday nights. Mikey lived life fully, and without pretense, guile or apology.

He is survived by the family he treasured above all else: wife, Annie, and children, Lily and Rory, who were his greatest joy. In addition, Mikey will be

remembered by his loving in-laws, Steve and DeeDee Shoemaker, stepsiblings, Michael Russell and Misty (Ray) Reed, and many aunts, uncles, cousins, nieces and nephews.
