Mildred "Mil" Marie (Wargel) Englert, 90, of Evansville, passed away Thursday, May 29, 2008 at Deaconess Hospice Center.

Mildred was born on April 17, 1918, the first born child of Johanna (Voelker) and Edward "Pop" Wargel. Mil, as she was later called, had four younger siblings, Virginia, Clarence, Claude and Leo. She was close to her siblings, especially Virginia who became her best pal.

She was a member of Corpus Christi Catholic Church, and enjoyed attending and volunteering at SWIRCA, dancing, playing cards and bingo. She began working at Servel in 1936 making 32 ½ cents an hour. After her marriage to Sylvester, they owned and operated Syl's Tavern. Later, she worked in the cafeteria at Old National Bank and part-time at the American Legion.

She was preceded in death by her husband, Sylvester, in 1986 whom she married on January 9, 1939, her parents, Johanna and Edward Wargel and her brothers, Clarence, Claude and Leo Wargel.

Mil is survived by two sons and their wives, Sylvester Englert, Jr. and Rebecca of Wadesville and Ronald Englert and Myrtle, of Evansville. Also surviving are her sister, Virginia London, of Evansville, a grandson and his wife, Jeff and Jamie Englert, a step grandson and his wife, Christopher and

Tini Perkins and a great grandson, Gavin Englert.
