Nancy Ann Owens Shively, age 69, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, February 12, 2012 at Deaconess Hospital.

Nancy had owned and operated Nancy Owens Arts and Crafts for over 20 years, was currently employed at the Department of Labor/Bureau of Statistics and had also worked for both H&R Block and Vowells and Shaaf Accountants. Nancy was an avid walker, exercise enthusiast and loved the outdoors. She had taught exercise classes at the YMCA, was past president of the Westside Business Association, current treasurer of the Preservation Alliance and past treasurer, editor and publisher of the Old Evansville Historic Association Newsletter. She was also a member of the Reitz Home.
