



## Nicholas E. "Nick" Goedde

Nicholas Edward "Nick" Goedde, 22, of St. Wendel, IN, passed away Sunday, January 6, 2008, while attending Indiana State University in Terre Haute, IN.

Nick was a 2004 graduate of North Posey High School and a member of Future Farmers of America while a student at the high school.

He is survived by his parents, Karen (Straub) and Frank Goedde of St. Wendel, IN, his sister, Alicia Goedde, at home, a brother, Chris Goedde of Blairsville, IN and his fiancée, Sheila Wasson of Hope, IN. Grandparents, Edna Mae and Harold Straub and John Goedde, all of St. Wendel and many aunts, uncles and cousins also survive Nick.

He was preceded in death by his grandmother, Frances Goedde.
