Noma Brizius, age 81, of Evansville, passed away Tuesday, May 16, 2022 at Deaconess Hospital Midtown Campus.

Noma was born December 13, 1941 in Paducah, KY to the late James Jacob and Nora (Nimmino) Cunningham. Noma worked as a registered nurse at Deaconess Hospital for 40 years; she was a member of the American Association of Critical Care Nurses, the Hoosier Hills Rug Hooking Guild and Red Hat Society. She attended The Turning Pointe Church.
