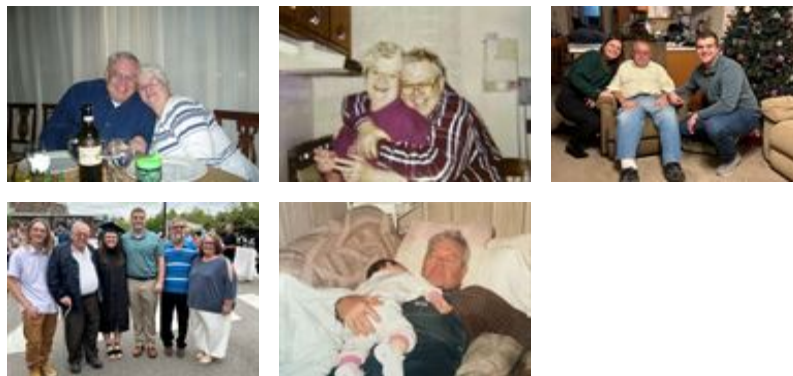

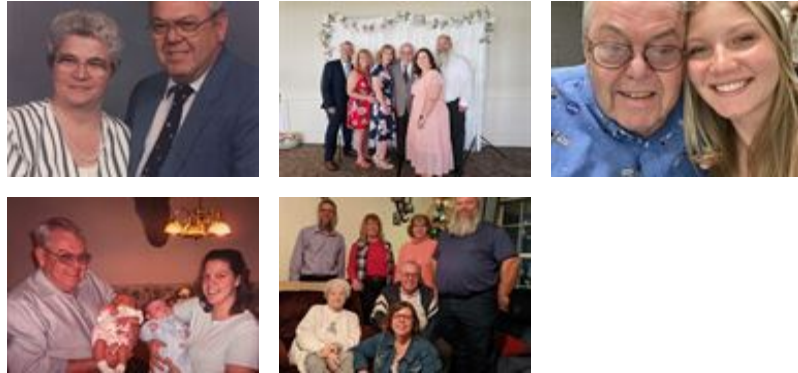

The list goes on and on with the accomplishments that he has done. Before he passed away, he made a military burial flag holder for our Daughter, Andrea, after she lost her husband unexpectedly.
