



## Norman A Schmitt

January 6, 1927 - April 18, 2016

Norman A. Schmitt, age 89, of Wadesville, passed away Monday, April 18, 2016 at New Harmonie Health Care.

Mr. Schmitt was a farmer for over 50 years. He was a member of St. Wendel Catholic Church where he was the first member of the church to serve as a Eucharistic Minister. He also served as president of the St. Wendel St. Vincent de Paul Society for 15 years and was a member of the Knights of St. John at St. Wendel.
