



## Norman Anthony Dewig

April 28, 1918 - January 1, 2012

Norman Anthony Dewig, age 93, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, January 1, 2012 at the Pine Haven Health and Rehabilitation Center.

Mr. Dewig had worked for Swift Packing Company for 23 years and later at Whirlpool before his retirement in 1983. Norman was a member of St. Joseph Catholic Church in the city.
