March 5, 1913

Omer A. Reinhart, 95, of Evansville, died Monday, January 19, 2009. Born March 5, 1913 in Evansville, Omer was the oldest of 10 children of Sophie and Edward Reinhart.

Omer married Mary Ruth Poehuis in 1939 and they celebrated their 50th Golden Wedding Anniversary before Mary Ruth's death in 1989. Omer was a businessman, graduating from Lockyear's Business College in 1930 and later became manager at Parsons Scoville. With small children at home during World War II, he worked as an accountant at Briggs. He owned and operated both the College Corner and the Dubl R Drive-In restaurants with his brother, Joe, for over 30 years. He retired in 1976 and was an early and active member of Fendrich Golf Club. He also enjoyed bowling, billiards and traveling with his wife.

He lived on East Mulberry Street from 1939 until 1995 when he moved to Solarbron Retirement Community. In June 2007 he moved to Pine Haven Health & Rehabilitation Center.

He is survived by his daughter and son-in-law, Barbara and Richard Roe of Evansville and two sons and daughters-in-law, Jim and Jane Reinhart of Bloomington, IN and John and Barbara Reinhart of Louisville, KY and his sister, Irma Singleton of Evansville. He was also blessed with eleven

grandchildren and twenty one great grandchildren.

Omer was preceded in death by his eight brothers.

Funeral services will begin at 10:00 A.M. Friday, January 23, 2009 at Corpus Christi Catholic Church, Rev. Eugene Schroeder officiating. Burial will follow in St. Joseph Catholic Cemetery.

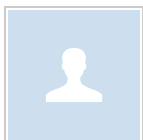
