Paul Hugh Roy, 93, of Evansville passed away Sunday, February 1, 2009 at The Terrace at Solarbron.

Mr. Roy was named after his ancestor, Hugh Roy, who immigrated from Ireland to Virginia in 1654.

Mr. Roy, with the help of his wife, Helen, had worked as the owner and operator of several grocery stores in the Howell area of Evansville, the last of which was Roy's 9 to 11 Market on Broadway Avenue. After his retirement in 1978, Paul enjoyed building new homes and in his spare time, fishing.

Surviving Mr. Roy are his daughter, Roselle Weinzapfel and her husband, Harold of St. Philip, IN; two grandchildren, Connie Weinzapfel and her husband, James E. Parrent, Jr. and Stan Weinzapfel and wife, Tami Weinzapfel-Smith, along with her children. Also surviving is a great grandson, Andrei W. Parrent.

Preceding Paul in death were his wife of 71 years, Helen (Mann) Roy; a daughter, Alice Pauline Roy; parents, Noah and Nora (Langford) Roy; three sisters, Edith Roy, Ina Jean (Roy) Nuhring and Charlotte (Roy) Holder and his brother, Richard H. Roy.
