



## Ralph Larry Bond

June 17, 1951 - March 16, 2021

Ralph “Larry” Bond, 69, of Evansville, passed away on Tuesday, March 16, 2021 at his home.

Larry was born June 17, 1951 in Evansville to the late Ralph Isaac and Mildred Elaine (Hazelrigg) Bond. He had worked for AMAX Coal Company at the Wright Mine in Newburgh and Beech Coal Company in Knox County, IN before retiring from Deig Brothers Construction in 2013. Larry was a 1969 graduate of Castle High School; was an avid fan of Reitz High School football; had served as president of the Big Blue Boosters and was a member of Howell General Baptist Church. Larry had also served as the financial secretary of the local United Mine Workers of America. Larry was also an avid billiards player.

Surviving Larry are two sons, Bryan Bond of Columbia, SC and Scott Bond of Evansville; a sister, Janice “Susan” (Delmer) Gross of Scottsburg, IN; brother, Terry (Janice) Bond of Boonville; seven grandchildren; several great grandchildren; one niece and two nephews.
