

## Ralph C. Seib

January 24, 1933 - January 10, 2024

Ralph C. Seib, 90, of Evansville, passed away on Wednesday, January 10, 2024 surrounded by family.

Ralph was born January 24, 1933 in Evansville to the late Edward and Valeda (Schrieber) Seib. He was an active, faithful member of St. Boniface Catholic Church and in 2003, along with his late wife Florence, was inducted into the Simon Brute` Society of the Diocese of Evansville for his service to the church. Ralph worked at Whirlpool Corporation for over 40 years before his retirement in 1993. Ralph was a member of the first graduating class of Mater Dei High School in 1950 and scored the first touchdown in Mater Dei history in 1949. He also participated in basketball and baseball while at Mater Dei. Ralph was an avid golfer and a member of Helfrich Hills Men's Club. He was a proud veteran of the United States Army serving during the Korean War. He was also a life member of the Knights of Columbus.

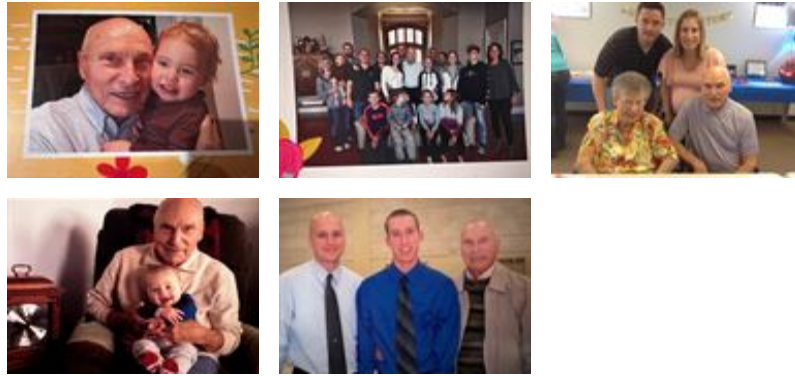
