Randall H. "Randy" Highman, 67, of Evansville, passed away Saturday, September 9, 2023 at St. Vincent Hospital in Evansville.

Randy was born October 12, 1955 in Evansville to the late Leland, Sr. and Cecilia (Stallings) Highman. He worked for Busler Enterprises for over 49 years, beginning in 1974. He also was a co-owner of TSRH Investments, LLC. Randy was a licensed pilot, completing his first solo flight in 1993 and he owned his own plane, a Piper Cherokee. Randy also had a 1966 Ford Mustang that he restored and showed in car shows, winning many awards. Randy was also a member of Salem Heusler Church.

Randy and his wife Debby built a large pole barn on the west side on five acres of ground. Randy had it full of all kinds of toys and he could use them all. Anything you needed; Randy had. He and Debby enjoyed sitting on the porch, watching and feeding the deer and watching their babies grow. On occasion, they would see a wild turkey or two stroll by. They enjoyed their camper and went camping with their friends whenever they could. They enjoyed sitting by the fire, roasting marshmallows while enjoying friends and making new ones along the way.

Surviving Randy are his wife of 21 years, Debra (Rexing) Highman; two very close cousins, Cathy Dale and Connie McDivitt and his best buddy and

business partner, Tim Schaefer. He also leaves behind his beloved cats, Toby, Benny and Calico.

In addition to his parents, Randy was preceded in death by a brother, Leland Highman, Jr.

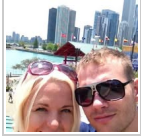
At North High School, I saw you everyday for two years.
