Rayburn Grubb, 92, of Evansville, passed away Sunday, February 21, 2021 at St. Vincent Hospital in Evansville.

Ray was born April 19, 1928 in Evansville to the late Lester and Louise (Warner) Grubb. He was a 1947 graduate of FJ Reitz High School, a veteran of the United States Army and a member of VFW Post #1114. Ray was also a member of Black's Chapel United Methodist Church in Mt.
