



Raymond Ahlering

June 10, 1912 - February 12, 2007

Raymond Ahlering, 94, passed away peacefully in his sleep on Monday, February 12, 2007, at White Oak Manor Nursing Care Center in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Raymond was born on June 10, 1912, in Evansville, Indiana. He was a graduate of the old Central High School downtown and played football while studying Civil Engineering at the University of Evansville in the early 1930s. Raymond was a master welder and worked in the plumbing trade in Evansville for many years, retiring from Sterling Brewery in 1974. He moved from Evansville to Charlotte, NC, in 1989, to be near his son's family and so that he could dote on his three granddaughters.

Raymond is survived by an only son, John and his wife, Beverly, of Murrells Inlet, South Carolina, three granddaughters, Beth Anne Ahlering of London, England, Joyce Marie Ahlering of Olympia, Washington, and Jane Ellen Ahlering of Charlotte, North Carolina; a brother and sister-in-law, Hugh and Carol Ahlering of Evansville, Indiana; and nieces, nephews, cousins and friends.

Raymond was preceded in death by his wife of 40 years, Mary Ellen, in 1980, his parents Elizabeth (Gerbig) Ahlering and Raymond Ahlering, Sr., sisters Katherine Beach and Virginia Hess.
