July 11, 1920 - January 17, 2007

Raymond L. Rush, 86, of St. Philip, Indiana, passed away peacefully Wednesday, January 17, 2007 at Select Specialty Hospital.

Ray was born in Connersville, IN on July 11, 1920 to Gertrude (Huther) and Raymond Rush. He graduated from Jasper High School in 1938 and was in the U. S. Army from 1942 to 1945 serving in the Philippines during World War II.

He was employed at Southern Railway for 41 years before retiring in 1981. He was a member of St. Philip Catholic Church, the Men's Club at the church, the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the St. Philip Conservation Club, Knights of Columbus, the American Legion and a lifetime member of VFW Post # 1114. He received the Brute Society Award from the Diocese of Evansville in 1994 for his stewardship to St. Philip Parish.

Ray is survived by his wife of 60 years, Elizabeth (Schroering) Rush, daughters, Kathleen (David) English, Janet (Paul) Witmeier and Alyce Dixon and sons, Marvin (Jeanne) Rush, Nicholas Rush and Richard (Jayni) Rush, thirteen grandchildren and nine great grandchildren.
