Raymond J. Weber, age 72, of Evansville, passed away Monday, April 11, 2011 at the home of his daughter surrounded by his loving family.

Mr. Weber was owner and operator of Ray Weber Painting for over 55 years. He learned this craft from his father. While painting was always his lifetime work, Ray also helped organize the Perry Township Volunteer Fire Department and farmed for many years. Later, he was a fireman for the City of Evansville and was Captain of the Snorkel Truck. He was a member of the Moose Lodge in Henderson and a former member of the Eagles, Twin Towers and the Riverbend Association.
