Rebekah was born January 5th, 1989 in Indianapolis, Indiana, to Dr. Curt and Nancy Shinabarger. She soon became best buddies with her older sister, Rachel. The family moved to Evansville, Indiana when she was three. By the time she was nine she gained twin brothers (Nathan and Noah) and a younger sister Elizabeth.
